- 2 In the following case, your class is cancelled.
 - (1) Classes from 10:00 A.M. to 11:40 A.M. on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday: In case a weather alert is given continually, up to 8:00 A.M., your class will be cancelled.
 - (2) Classes from 6:30 P.M. to 8:10 P.M. on Tuesday, and Wednesday.

 In case a weather alert is given continually up to 4:00 P.M., your class will be cancelled.
 - (3) Classes from 3:10 P.M. to 4:50 P.M. on Saturday
 In case a weather alert is given continually up to 1:00 P.M., your class will be cancelled.

3 NOTE:

- OPIEF will not individually send student any specific information about a class cancellation. Each student should be responsible for the alert information on TV or Radio.
- OPIEF will not provide any substitute class to compensate for a cancelled class.
